# *Future Jobs Fund* **Conservation Worker**

## **WHAT THE SCOTTISH WILDLIFE TRUST CAN OFFER**

### **Real work experience -**

- We undertake **actual conservation work** in a real work environment, providing constant **hands on experience**, essential for the learning and consolidation of new skills;
- All work helps protect and enhance our wildlife reserves and the countryside in general.

### **Variety -**

- Sites are varied, mainly **wildlife sites and reserves**, but also extending to the wider countryside;
- Tasks also vary greatly, from for example tree felling to wildlife garden creation;
- Work will **vary throughout the seasons**.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- You must be **eligible for Future Jobs Fund** to take up this job, ie be **unemployed**, have been **signing on for 26 weeks or more**, and be **aged 18-24**;
- Pay is **£203 per week**. *You are advised to check how this job would affect other benefits you may be receiving*;
- Hours are **35 per week**;
- The job lasts for **26 weeks**;
- **Transport to and from the worksites** is provided;
- **Health & Safety** and all other instruction is delivered as a matter of course;
- **Lantra training** is available as necessary;
- All necessary **tools & equipment** are provided;
- **Protective boots and a work fleece** are provided.

## **TO APPLY PLEASE**

- **Visit your local jobcentre** and ask about our vacancies under Future Jobs Fund. Your jobcentre will then check your eligibility.
- **Complete an application form available at the jobcentre** and send it to us. We will then contact selected applicants and invite them for interview.
