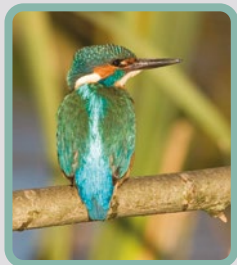

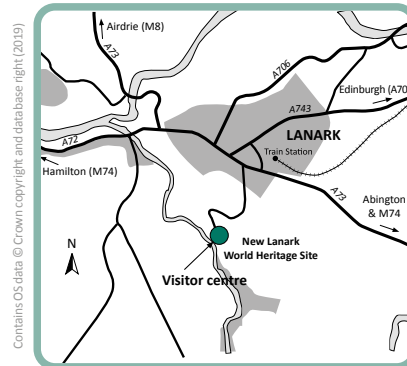

By car

One mile (1.6 km) south of Lanark, off the A73. Follow brown signs for New Lanark World Heritage Site. The Falls of Clyde Visitor Centre is located within the village of New Lanark. Follow the badger signs to the Dyeworks building. Car parking charge of £3 per car applies.

By train and bus

Train and bus station located in Lanark. Regular bus from Lanark to New Lanark (Service SPT 135).

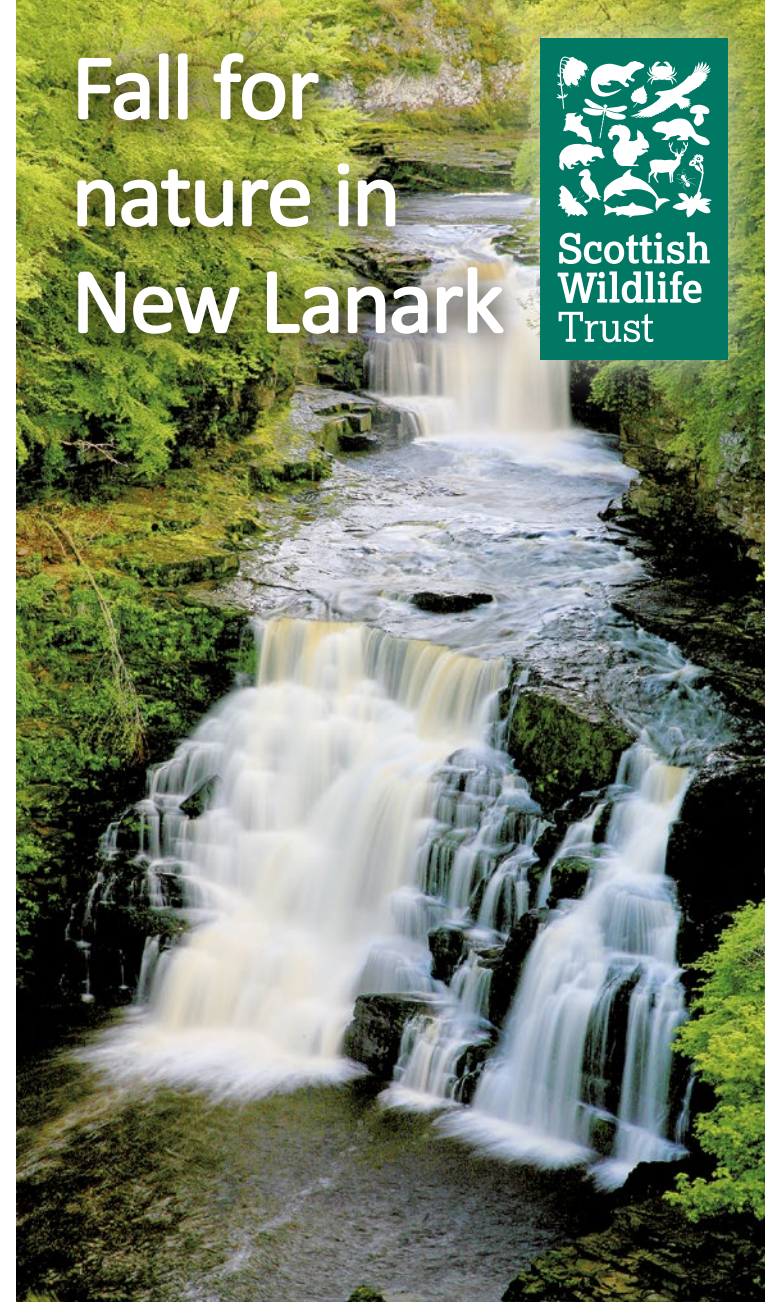

A waymarked walk in an inspirational landscape with three dramatic waterfalls and abundant wildlife. Join us at our summer dipper watching events at the start of the reserve.



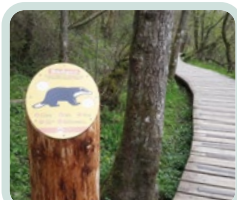
Badgers
