Objective(s) of your volunteer role
To help conserve and protect wildlife on our local reserves, and to enable people to access the reserves and to improve and enrich the local community greenspaces.
Tasks
Basic reserve maintenance such as supporting pathways, clearing vegetation, planting trees, making homes for wildlife, doing surveys. All work will be outdoor based. The work may be physically strenuous and the work will involve use of hand tools.

A willingness to help out, a willingness to learn. No formal qualifications needed, just a love of wildlife and its conservation.
