Objective(s) of your volunteer role

To provide monitoring support to the Species Protections Officer and Ranger throughout the 'Osprey Watch' season.

Tasks

- To monitor for the nesting ospreys for any incidence of disturbance.
- To observe the behaviour and movements of the ospreys.
- Record observations using tablet-based app.
- Communicate with other staff members and volunteers.
- To speak to visitors in an informative and friendly manner.
- To record other wildlife when observed.
- To act as an ambassador for the work of The Trust.

Description of the personal attributes/skills/qualifications required

- Good wildlife ID skills (or a willingness to improve wildlife ID)
- Willingness to work unsociable hours and in cold weather
- Availability over the duration of the nesting season
- Good communication skills
- Positive, cooperative attitude
- Ability to engage members of the public in a welcoming and informative manner
- Ability to work as part of a team
- Willingness to use simple tablet-based app to record osprey behaviour
