



## Make your own Spring daffodil

## What you will need:

- Toilet roll tube x1
- Kitchen roll tube x1
- A4 plain paper x 3 sheets
- Glue or tape
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Crayons, colouring pencils or felt tips (1 yellow, 1 green)


## How to make your daffodil:

- 1. Cut the toilet roll tube in half (this will be the centre of your daffodil) and place into the centre of a piece of plain paper.
- 2. Draw petal shapes all the way around the toilet roll tube. Then cut out the whole shape of the flower (not individual petals) and colour in yellow.




- 3. Take the second sheet of paper. Cut a strip that is the same width as the cut toilet roll tube and colour the strip in yellow.
- 4. Measure the amount of the paper strip needed to wrap around the tube and cut off the remainder, then glue the strip around the cut toilet roll tube.





- Make some small cuts along one edge of the yellow paper tube and fold these sections back to make tabs.
- 6. Apply glue to the tabs and stick to the centre of your petals.



7. Take a kitchen roll tube and the last piece of paper, and cut a strip of the paper large enough to wrap around the tube.



- 8. Colour the paper in green and glue this around the kitchen roll tube to make your stem.
- All that's left to do, is to stick the flower to the stem. Then place in a sunny spot and admire!
