- Ensure a high standard of compliance with Health and Safety laws and Trust policies.
- Maintain good communication between Scottish Wildlife Trust and stakeholders, including Scourie Estate and Handa Ferry.
- Ensure that visitor satisfaction levels are maintained at a consistently high level.
- Induct and supervise a programme of up to six long term placements
- Monitor work carried out by contractors and work parties.
- To organise a programme of reserve maintenance to ensure buildings and infrastructure are maintained to the required standards and are presentable and tidy.
- To monitor the populations and productivity of seabirds on Handa according to JNCC methods. To conduct survey work of other taxa as required.
- To carry out monitoring and control of brown rats.
- To produce the annual reserve report and present this to the reserve management group.
- Update the Handa Ranger's Manual at the end of the season and conduct an on-island induction for a successive Ranger.
