Conservation Volunteer - Aberdeenshire

Location

You would be working on our nature reserves in Aberdeenshire; Gight Wood, Longhaven Cliffs, Red Moss of Netherley and Coulnacraig meadow

How many volunteers are needed?

Up to 4 per work day

How many hours per day/per week are you needed?

1 - 2 days per week preferred

On which days are you needed?

During the work week, Monday to Friday

On what date do we want you to start?

At any time between April and September

End Date (if applicable)

The season will finish around end of September

Minimum commitment we require from you (eg 1 day per week for 6 months). If any.

We would prefer volunteers who can offer 1 full days per week or a similar regular commitment

Objective(s) of your volunteer role

To work as part of a small team of volunteers to help the Scottish Wildlife Trust Ranger for Aberdeenshire carry out a range of practical tasks on our reserves.

Tasks

Tasks will cover a range of conservation and reserve management activities which may include path and access management, control of invasive and undesirable vegetation, tree felling, boardwalk maintenance, grassland management and monitoring.

Volunteers will use a range of hand tools. All supervision and instruction will be provided by the Ranger.

Description of the personal attributes/skills/qualifications required

- Volunteers must be relatively fit and be able to walk moderate distances on uneven terrain.
- You must be prepared to undertake physical work in the outdoors sometimes in poor weather.
- Ideally you would need your own transport to meet the ranger on site or be able to travel to Westhill from where a lift will be available.
